

Elective courses 2025-2026

The aim

To deepen your theoretical knowledge, you can choose from various course units in your master's program. With these course units, you refine or broaden your individual curriculum. Your theoretical studies are meant to nourish your artistic practice and to help you learn how to reflect. Some course units are organized as intensive courses, while others are spread over one semester. In the ECTS course descriptions, you can find more information about the content and teaching methods of each elective.

Practrical information

- You will take two elective courses in the Master's programme.
- All elective courses take place in the first semester.
- Two elective courses are organised as intensive weeks.
- Attendance at classes is mandatory.
- Each elective is worth 6 credits, i.e. 168 hours of study time: 24 hours of contact time + 144 hours of self-study
- The self-study for all elective courses is intensive: we expect you to thoroughly familiarise yourself with a reader of articles and reflect critically on them. Each elective course guides you in a different way in that reading.

What to take in account when you make a choice?

- Rank the elective courses offered according to your preference, with 1 being your absolute preference and 3 being an elective course you would rather not take.
- Read the course descriptions carefully: what appeals to you?
- Attendance at lectures is compulsory for most elective courses. Please read this carefully on the ECTS sheets.
- Each elective course is worth 6 credits, i.e. 168 hours of study time: 24 hours of contact time + 144 hours of self-study.
- The self-study for all elective courses is intensive: we expect you to thoroughly familiarise yourself with a reader of articles and to reflect critically on them. For each of the elective courses, the lecturer will guide you in a different way in that reading.

Submit your choice

- Via this <u>LINK</u> you can submit from 10th of September your choice.
- You rank the offered electives according to your preference, where 1 is your absolute preference and 3 is an elective that you prefer not to take.
- The deadline to indicate your preference is:
 Thursday 18th of September before 22h. Then we close the form and start puzzling to assign all students 2 courses. We aim to have all personal schedules supplemented with the assigned electives by Sunday at 12h.
- On Monday 22th of September you start your classes.

Teaching methods: Groupdiscussions

5 x 3h/week on Monday 13h30 from 22th of September 2025 And 15th of December 2025 9h – 18h with guest lecturers

Assessment: Podcast/soundscape (8 out of 20): In 20 minute original edit, you share the insights you

made during the class conversation, the guestlectures and your study of the texts.

Conversation series (8 out of 20): Together with your group you are well prepared, by reading the asigned articles, to participate - during every contactmoment - in the groupdiscussions, in the role of presenter (for one text) or discussant (for the other texts).

Self-assessment (4 out of 20): You write 1 page reflecting on your own learning process, proposing a score out of 20 and arguing why you think you deserve this score regarding the objectives of this course. Think about your presence in class, the conversation series

and the podcast you made.
